### ADVICE TO PARTICIPANTS

1. Please complete ALL the information requested at the top of this page.
2. Make sure that your Local Organiser knows that you are taking part. If you are riding to support the Friends of Kent Churches but not wishing to support a particular church with 50% of your sponsorship money, and therefore have no local organiser, please contact our county organiser for details of how to pass on your forms and sponsorship money: Rosemary Dymond: [kent.rs.countyorg@gmail.com](mailto:kent.rs.countyorg@gmail.com)
3. Wear a Sticker Badge, available from your Local Organiser or at your first church or chapel visited.
4. Study and conform to the requirements of the Highway Code. Ensure that your bicycle is in a roadworthy condition before starting to ride. Friends of Kent Churches strongly advise wearing cycle helmets.

5. Plan your route for the day, not only to achieve a large number of church visits but also to enable you to explore some of the many beautiful areas of Kent. Leave details of your route with someone at home.
6. If a church is listed as open, but due to unforeseen circumstances is closed, riders and striders may count this church in their total. If there is a Welcome Form posted outside a closed church please sign it!
7. The Friends of Kent Churches accept no liability in respect of death or injury sustained by any participant, or damage to property. If participants wish to have insurance cover, they must make their own arrangements.
8. Riding or striding on a day other than the second Saturday in September is not part of the official event promoted by the Friends of Kent Churches.
9. Participants under the age of 18 years should seek parental consent before joining the Ride & Stride.
