The Street, Wormshill
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2019

To allow cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of The Street, Wormshill.

A closure is planned from 24th September 2019 for up to 1 day between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30, or where stated on a valid permit (BC005OP1W00000IBBEA3PU01 - BT). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works permit will be displayed on www.roadworks.org


The Street will be closed from the junction with Park Lane and continue north for 7110m, or to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while cabling works are undertaken by BT.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via The Street, Lords Hill, Syndale Bottom Road, Ringlestone Road and vice versa.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
